	Signature Blocks (CE/ED/IND)	<p>Load the signature block (reflecting the sector you work in) during the week leading up to and on World Teachers' Day in order to celebrate Canberra Teachers within and beyond your school.</p>
	Virtual meeting background	<p>If you're teaching, learning, or working remotely, use the virtual meeting background leading up to and on World Teachers' Day.</p>
	Tile for school digital screen	<p>Place a message thanking teachers and promoting the day through your community on your school's digital screen.</p>
	Blue Ribbon	<p>Place blue ribbons on the school fence, on a tree in the playground, or any other idea you have! Use #CelebrateCanberraTeachers to show how you celebrate your teachers.</p>
	Poster	<p>We have personalised the ready-made AITSL poster template for you to drop in a photo and create your own posters for your school community.</p>
